#### **Focus on Results: Enhancing Capacity Across Sectors in Transition II –Participant Training (FORECAST II – PT) Indefinite Quantity Contract (IDIQ) #AID-OAA-I-12-00008**

World Learning holds the FORECAST II – PT IQC. Participant training is a cross-cutting tool that transfers new skills and knowledge to improve the performance of host country individuals in their workplace. Through the FORECAST II – PT IQC World Learning can provide USAID Missions with the full range of participant training interventions including: all facets of planning, training needs assessments, and coordination; program design, procuring intervention providers, participant selection, processing, orientation, tracking and reporting; and evaluation and follow-up.
