Program Overview



In response to the U.S. Embassy in Baghdad's commitment to youth economic development in Iraq, World Learning has developed the English Language Investment and Training for Economic Success (ELITES) program.

World Learning ELITES (English Language Investment and Training for Economic Success) is a virtual program designed for unemployed Iraqi youth ages 18–25 who are currently enrolled in university or are recent high school or university graduates seeking job opportunities in the private sector.

ELITES brings together 100 Iraqi students for an innovative, one-year mentoring program focused on private sector employment training and entrepreneurship.

The ELITES program aims to strengthen young Iraqis' key employability and professional networking skills and develop their ability to identify viable career options so they can ultimately, gain meaningful private sector jobs.

Program Dates: December 19, 2021 - July 31, 2022

Application Deadline: November 20, 2021

Eligibility Requirements



- You are between 18 and 25 years old at the time the program starts on December 19, 2021
- You are actively seeking employment
- You have at least high beginner level of English language proficiency when applying
- You are an Iraqi citizen residing in Iraq
- You are available to commit about 10 hours of work per week on the program requirements


Implementation – Stage 1

Recruitment, Development & Networking Event

In support of World Learning's diversity, equity, and inclusion initiative, the program aims to recruit:

- Participants from 18 cities across Iraq
- o An equal number of men and women
- Participants with either a university or a high school diploma, or who have completed Technical and Vocational Education Training (TVET)
- Participants from a variety of vocational and academic specialties and fields

The course will include practical exercises to improve participants' awareness of private-sector opportunities and success in the job search process.

Job Shadowing with Professional Mentorship

Participants will engage in a regional real-work simulation event to practice applying their integrated skills and receive real-time feedback on their performance.

Implementation – Stage 3



Job Fair & Closing Event

Job Fair

The program will culminate with a virtual job fair, which will bring all of the program's participants together to watch presentations from professionals, explore virtual, private sector company booths, and network with representatives from private sector employers. Participants will come away with new professional contacts and a clearer understanding of available employment opportunities.

Closing Event

Following the job fair, participants will join a final virtual session to share and reflect on their growth during the program, present on important topics related to the private sector job market, and outline how they plan use their new skills to fulfill their goals and pursue future employment.

Upon program completion, participants will have opportunities to network with potential employers and apply the skills they have learned through job shadowing opportunities with professionals in the private sector and opportunities to network with potential employers.
